

# ***Gospel Outbound Progress Report***

## ***January – August 2024***

### **1. Radio DMM Teaching Program**

- a. Radio teaching and talk show twice weekly, reaching up to 2 million listeners on the most popular N. Ugandan Christian radio station.
  - i. Sixty shows have been presented this year to date.

### **2. DMM – Disciple Making Movements**

- a. Seminars were held in the following villages for five days, at 6 hours/day.
  - i. Apaa, with 26 participants
  - ii. Lakiti, with 37 participants
  - iii. Wiko, with 17 participants

### **3. DBS – Discovery Bible Studies**

- a. Small Multiplying Groups formed as a result of our DMM Seminars and Outreach Ministers.
  - i. 80 Groups currently
    - 1. Thirty-seven DBS groups were added in the last six months.

### **4. Bibles – We distributed 130 Bibles to the DBS groups.**

- a. These are local language bibles.

### **5. MND - Mosquito Net Distribution**

- a. We have distributed 1800 nets.
  - i. 1300 nets went to children from 3-15 years old. These cover 2600 children since 2 children are covered with each net.
  - ii. 300 nets went to mothers with infants.
  - iii. 200 nets went to older people.
  - iv. In total 3100 individuals received net coverage.

### **6. ECE – Economic Community Empowerment**

- a. Women’s tailoring training in our Gulu, N. Ugandan training facility.
  - i. Fifty-three women have completed their tailoring training through our school this year.
- b. GO Outbound
  - i. Businesses are financed by restricted giving for long-term local ministry funding.
    - 1. Real Estate Investments – land and rental units
    - 2. Trucking transport – construction sand hauling

### **7. Orphanage Support**

- a. We continue to support 46 village orphans from different villages with school fees and supplies.
  - i. 28 Ugandan and 18 from South Sudan.

### **8. Gospel Sports Program – New this year.**

- a. We sponsor soccer with gospel outreach in Gulu and neighboring villages. We have reached 70 children with two groups, 7-15 and 16-22.
- b. Gospel dance and drama are also promoted to reach out to the community on a weekly basis
